



Information pursuant to art. 13 of the European Regulation 679/2016 and consent

Pursuant to art. 13 of the European Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereafter GDPR), and in relation to the personal data of which the Mario Diana Foundation Onlus will become available with the completion of the assignment / contract or commercial relationship in existence, we communicate the following:

Data controller and responsible for the protection of personal data

The data controller is the New Humanity Association (hereinafter New Humanity) - with registered office in Grottaferrata (RM), via Piave, n. 15. The Owner can be contacted via pec (new-humanity@legalmail.it) or email (info@new-humanity.org). New Humanity has appointed a person responsible for the protection of personal data (RPD, data protection officer, DPO) in the person in charge of the secretariat that can be contacted at the email info@new-humanity.org.

Purpose of data processing

The treatment is aimed at the correct and complete execution of the professional assignment received, both in judicial and extrajudicial field. Your data will also be processed in order to:

- fulfill the obligations required for tax and accounting purposes;
- respect the obligations incumbent on New Humanity in relation to the collaboration agreement signed with the Mario Diana Foundation onlus with registered office in Caserta, via Maria Sklodowska Curie, 24 and other obligations under the current legislation.

Personal data may be processed by means of both paper and electronic files (including portable devices) and processed in ways strictly necessary to meet the aforementioned purposes.

Legal basis of the processing

New Humanity processes your personal data lawfully, where the treatment:

- is necessary for the execution of a business relationship, contract or assignment of task of which you are a part or to carry out pre-contractual measures adopted on request;
- is necessary to fulfill a legal obligation incumbent on New Humanity;
- is based on the expressed consent, such as the sending of a newsletter by New Humanity.

Consequences of failure to communicate personal data

With regard to personal data relating to the execution of the contract of which you are party or related to the fulfillment of a regulatory obligation (for example the obligations related to the keeping of accounting records and tax), failure to disclose personal data prevents the execution of the contractual relationship.

Data retention

Your personal data, object of treatment for the above mentioned purposes, will be kept for the duration of the contract and, subsequently, for the time in which New Humanity is subject to conservation obligations for fiscal purposes or for other purposes foreseen by legal or regulatory provisions.

Data communication

Your personal data may be disclosed to:

1. the Mario Diana Foundation onlus based on the collaboration agreement signed with



New Humanity;

2. consultants and accountants or other lawyers who provide functional services for the purposes indicated above;
3. banking and insurance institutions that provide functional services for the purposes indicated above;
4. subjects who process data in execution of specific legal obligations;
5. Judicial or administrative authorities, for the fulfillment of legal obligations.

Profiling and Data Dissemination

Your personal data are not subject to disclosure or to any fully automated decision-making process, including profiling.

Rights of the interested party

Among the rights recognized by the GDPR are those of:

- The request to New Humanity for access to your personal data and information relating to them; the correction of inaccurate data or the integration of incomplete data; the cancellation of personal data concerning you (upon the occurrence of one of the conditions indicated in article 17, paragraph 1 of the GDPR and in compliance with the exceptions provided for in paragraph 3 of the same article); the limitation of the processing of your personal data (upon the use of one of the hypotheses indicated in Article 18, paragraph 1 of the GDPR);
- request and obtain from New Humanity - in the cases in which the legal basis of the treatment is the contract or consent, and the same is done by automated means - your personal data in a structured and machine-readable format, also in order to communicate such data to another data controller (so-called right to the portability of personal data);
- oppose at any time the processing of your personal data to the occurrence of particular situations that affect you;
- revoke the consent at any time, limited to the cases in which the processing is based on your consent for one or more specific purposes and with regard to common personal data (for example date and place of birth or place of residence), or particular categories of data (for example, data revealing your racial origin, your political opinions, your religious beliefs, your health status or your sex life). However, the treatment based on consent and carried out prior to the revocation of the same preserves its lawfulness;
- propose a complaint to a supervisory authority (Authority for the protection of personal data - www.garanteprivacy.it).
